do not provide you with the citation, so you will need to create them yourself if you use information from these sources.

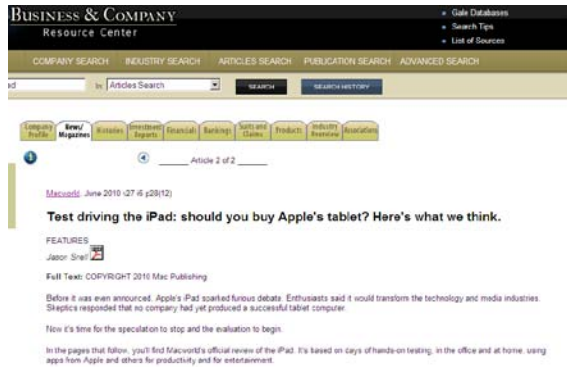
It is easy to do with a free website called <http://www.bibme.com>. You will need to register for the site, but it is free and is likely a site you will use again for other papers.



Once you have registered click on the **Magazine** tab, then choose **Manual Entry** mode.



Here is an actual article from a database:

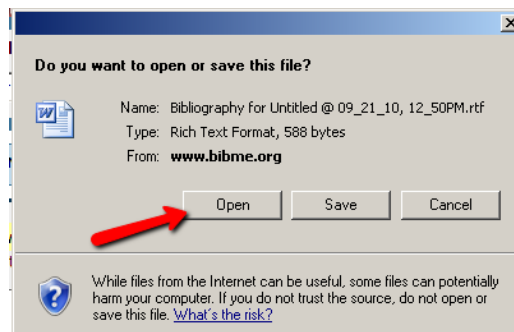


All of the information you need to enter for the citation in BibMe is located on the article's page.

When you have entered all of the information click **Add to My Bibliography**.

A new screen will open. Make sure you choose Format: **APA** then click **Download**

A new screen will pop up. Click **Open**.



A document will open. Your citation will be the type of information in the box. Copy and paste that into your own References page.
