Infotrac

Infotrac is a collection of 30 individual databases that includes both full-text sources and abstracts covering a wide range of subject areas. The databases, and a brief description of each, are:

***Academic One File** – Coverage of the physical sciences, technology, medicine, social sciences, the arts, theology, literature and other subjects. Also includes full-text coverage of the *New York Times* back to 1995.

Business and Company Resource Center with PROMT and Newsletters – International trade and business journals, industry newsletters, and newspapers, plus summaries from *Investext*® investment and brokerage firm reports.

Business Index ASAP – Focus on management issues, economic indicators and business theories and practices, as well as on the activities of companies and industries worldwide.

***Computer Database** – Periodicals on the computer, telecommunications and electronics industries.

***Custom Newspapers** – Newspapers from around the world

***Expanded Academic ASAP** – Articles on the social sciences, humanities, behavioral, health sciences, science and technology.

***Gale Virtual Reference Library** - Encyclopedias, almanacs, and specialized reference sources for multidisciplinary research on varied topics including the arts, biography, business, environment, history, criminal justice/law, literature, medicine, multicultural studies, science, and social science.

***General Business File ASAP** - periodicals, newspapers, newswires, company profiles and investment reports.

***Health Reference Center Academic** - Full text and images of respected nursing, allied health and medical journals; consumer health magazines; newsletters; pamphlets; newspaper articles; topical overviews; and reference books.

Health and Wellness Resource Center and Alternative Health Module - Collection of books, journals, magazines and pamphlets on alternative and complimentary therapies.

***Informe!** A collection of hispanic magazines with full text. Covers business, health, technology, culture, current topics and other subjects.

***General OneFile** - News and periodical articles on a wide range of topics.

***LegalTrac** – Articles from major law reviews, legal newspapers, bar association journals and international legal journals.

Literature Resources from Gale - Critical essays plot summaries, author biographies and articles from literary journals.

Newsletters ASAP – Articles from specialized business, industry and technology newsletters.

***Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center** - Topic overviews, magazine and newspaper articles, primary source documents, and statistics for today's hottest social issues.

***Student Resource Center Gold** - Biographies, topical essays, background information, critical analyses, magazines, and newspapers on a wide range of topics.

***Agriculture Collection** – focused on agriculture and its related fields

***Business Economics and Theory Collection** - Economic development, forecasting, and history; fiscal theory; monetary theory and financial institutions; business finance; public finance; country studies; and government regulations.

***Communications and Mass Media Collection** - Advertising and public relations, linguistics, and literature.

***Criminal Justice Collection** – Criminal Justice and Paralegal topics.

***Culinary Arts Collection** – Cooking and nutrition.

***Environmental Studies and Policy Collection** – Diverse coverage of environmental issues and policies.

* **Fine Arts and Music Collection** - Broad coverage of the arts from music and music theory to drama and the performing arts and the visual arts.

***Gardening, Landscape and Horticulture Collection** - key issues in gardening, landscaping, and other areas of horticulture.

***Home Improvement Collection** - Architectural techniques, tool and material selection, zoning requirements, etc.

***Nursing and Allied Health Collection** - Nursing, biomedicine, health sciences, consumer health and allied health disciplines.

***Popular Magazines** - Consumer Reports, Time, National Geographic, The New Yorker, Newsweek, Vanity Fair, US News and World Report, Vogue, Fortune, Business Week, National Review, Cosmopolitan, NPR and even Oprah are included in this database.

***Psychology Collection** – Articles on the mind, emotions and how the human mind develops over time.

***Tourism, Hospitality and Leisure Collection** – Covers the hospitality and tourism fields.

ProQuest

Proquest includes 8 databases which includes both full-text sources and abstracts.

ABI/INFORM Dateline - Focusing on hard-to-find local and regional business news coverage of large corporations, privately held companies, local start-ups, executive profiles, marketing, finance, and industry news. Provides access to business information not typically found in national news sources. Contains news and analysis, information on local markets, and more gathered from major business tabloids, magazines, daily newspapers, wire services, and city, state, and regional business publications.

ABI/INFORM Global - Search nearly 3000 worldwide business periodicals for in-depth coverage of business and economic conditions, management techniques, theory, and practice of business, advertising, marketing, economics, human resources, finance, taxation, computers, and more. Expanded international coverage. Fast access to information on 60,000 + companies with business and executive profiles. Includes The Wall Street Journal.

ABI/INFORM Trade & Industry - More than 1200 business periodicals with a trade or industry focus. Provides users with the latest industry news, product and competitive information, marketing trends, and a wide variety of other topics. Contains publications on every major industry, including finance, insurance, transportation, construction, and many more.

Proquest Research Library - Provides one-stop access to a wide range of popular academic subjects. The database includes more than 2,800 titles in full text—from 1971 forward. It features a highly-respected, diversified mix of scholarly journals, trade publications, magazines, and newspapers. It consists of two components: a core list of periodicals; plus 15 supplemental subject-specific modules. Subject modules include: Arts, Business, Children, Education, General Interest, Health, Humanities, International, Law, Military, Multicultural, Psychology, Sciences, Social Science, Women's Interest

Health & Medical Complete – Provides coverage for all major clinical and healthcare disciplines, including medical sciences, immunology, pharmacy and pharmacology, nursing, physical fitness and hygiene, surgery, and others. In addition, the database includes all charts, diagrams, graphs, tables, photos, and other graphical elements essential to medical research.

Psychology Journals – Coverage of clinical and social psychology, genetics, psychology of business and economics, communication, criminology, addiction, education, gerontology, linguistics, hypnosis, psychiatry, neurology and social welfare.

ProQuest Nursing & Allied Health Source – Covers over 70 wide-ranging topics including: Cytology, Nursing, Nutrition, Oncology, Pediatric Care, Pharmacology, Public Health, Radiology

National Newspaper Abstracts – Abstracts of articles from the New York Times, USA Today and the Wall Street Journal.
